- Regular monthly Pastoral Council meetings, 6:30pm, the 4th Tuesday of the month (except the months of July and December).
- Additionally, you may be invited to serve on parish ad-hoc committees and organizations.

What qualifications are needed?

• Registered member of Saint Anne Catholic Church.
